SUBJECT: Action Items from Interagency Commission Session on 6.18.08

On June 18, 2008, Mayor Adrian M. Fenty conducted an Interagency Collaboration and Services Integration Commission (ICSIC) Session on Goal 5: Children & Youth Live in Healthy, Stable, and Supportive Families. The Department of Human Services and the Child and Families Services Agency were lead agencies. This memo identifies specific action items that agency directors committed to accomplish in order to improve government services in their respective agencies.

ICSIC Action Items

Department of Human Services

- Assist non-custodial parents, with child support orders, in increasing their earning potential (Timeline: 30 days)
- Complete draft plan on aggressively targeting child support payments – include realistic goals and strategies (Timeline: 30 days)
- Determine targets for how many children will be lifted out of poverty, considering where we are now, and where we would like to be; consider 5,000 as goal for this year (Timeline: 14 days)
- Determine TANF benefits in real time for Atlanta, Boston and San Francisco, and lay out the total value of TANF benefits and related services in comparison with these cities (Timeline: 14 days)
- Lead the development of the Unified Case Management System (Timeline: 60 days for plan, 120 days for pilot)

District of Columbia Public Schools

- Roll out focuses for high schools by the end of next school year

Department of Mental Health

- Lead the development of protocols for end of life planning in collaboration with **Child and Family Services Agency** and the **Office of the Attorney General** (Timeline: 60 days)
