


DCPS School(s) of Right for Elementary School Students 2013-14



This map displays the school(s) of right by boundary (not by feeder pattern) throughout the city. Each color and name of school represent a distinct set of school(s) of right. Approximately 78% of elementary-grade students have a right to just one elementary or education campus school based on where they live. Those areas of the city are displayed with a boundary that lists just one school name. However, another 22% of public school PK3-5th grade students have rights to 2 or 3 elementary or education campus schools based on where they live due to previous DCPS closures and consolidations. Those areas of the city are displayed with a boundary that lists two or more school names.
