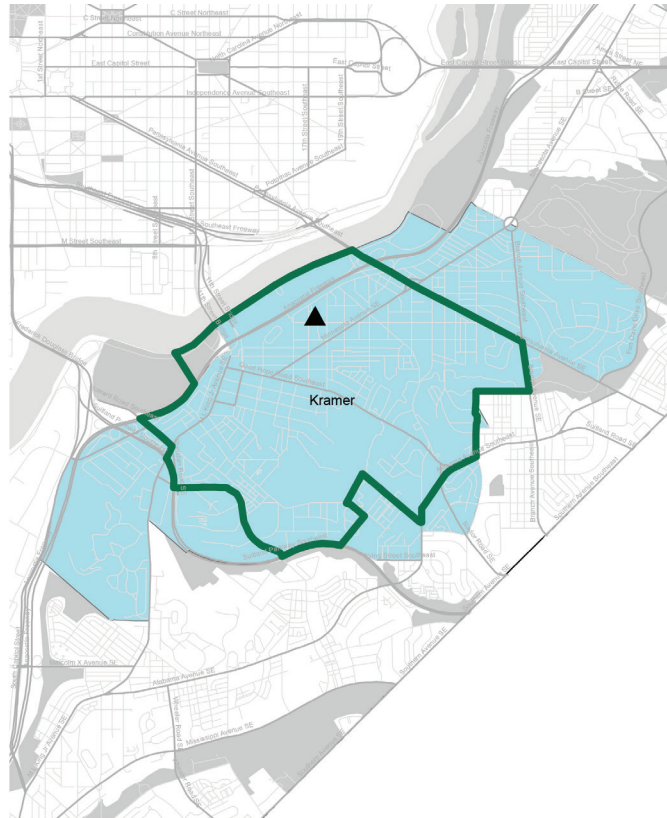
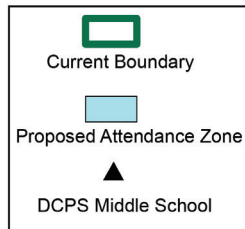


Proposed Boundary Changes for Kramer Middle School 1700 Q St. SE

Kramer Middle School is the public school of right for all school-age children living within the attendance zone. Families can also apply to charter schools or out of boundary to DCPS schools through a lottery process.

Rationale for Proposed Boundary Changes: The Kramer MS boundary is made up of the proposed boundaries of the elementary schools designated to feed geographically into Kramer.

Proposed Geographic Destination Feeder Schools (Feeder Pathway): Anyone living in the proposed new boundaries for Ketcham ES, Moten ES, Orr ES, Randle Highlands ES, Savoy ES, or Stanton ES is zoned for and has a right to attend Kramer MS and Anacostia HS. Any student attending a feeder elementary school out-of-boundary has the right to continue in the feeder pattern to Kramer. Proposed feeder pattern changes were made to better align school building capacity with population and with feeder pattern participation rates and to support racial/ethnic and socio-economic diversity, where possible.

Proposed Programmatic Destination School (Feeder Pathway): No programmatic feeder pattern proposed.
