

Preliminary Boundary Revisions for DCPS Elementary Schools

Initial Decision Factors	Proposed Boundary Changes
Closed schools with attendance areas reallocated: Rudolph, Clark, and Brookland	Consolidate Brookland and Bunker Hill. Reallocate Rudolph and Clark Boundaries.
High growth now and growth projected for child population in Cluster 18 Buildings are over capacity at Brightwood, Powell, Truesdell, Barnard, Raymond, Bruce-Monroe @ Park View.	Expand West's boundary to relieve crowding in Powell and Brightwood. Reduce number of grades served to increase capacity in elementary school facilities. Explore development of stand-alone early childhood centers.
Buildings are over capacity at Brightwood, Powell, Truesdell, Barnard, Raymond, Bruce-Monroe @ Park View.
