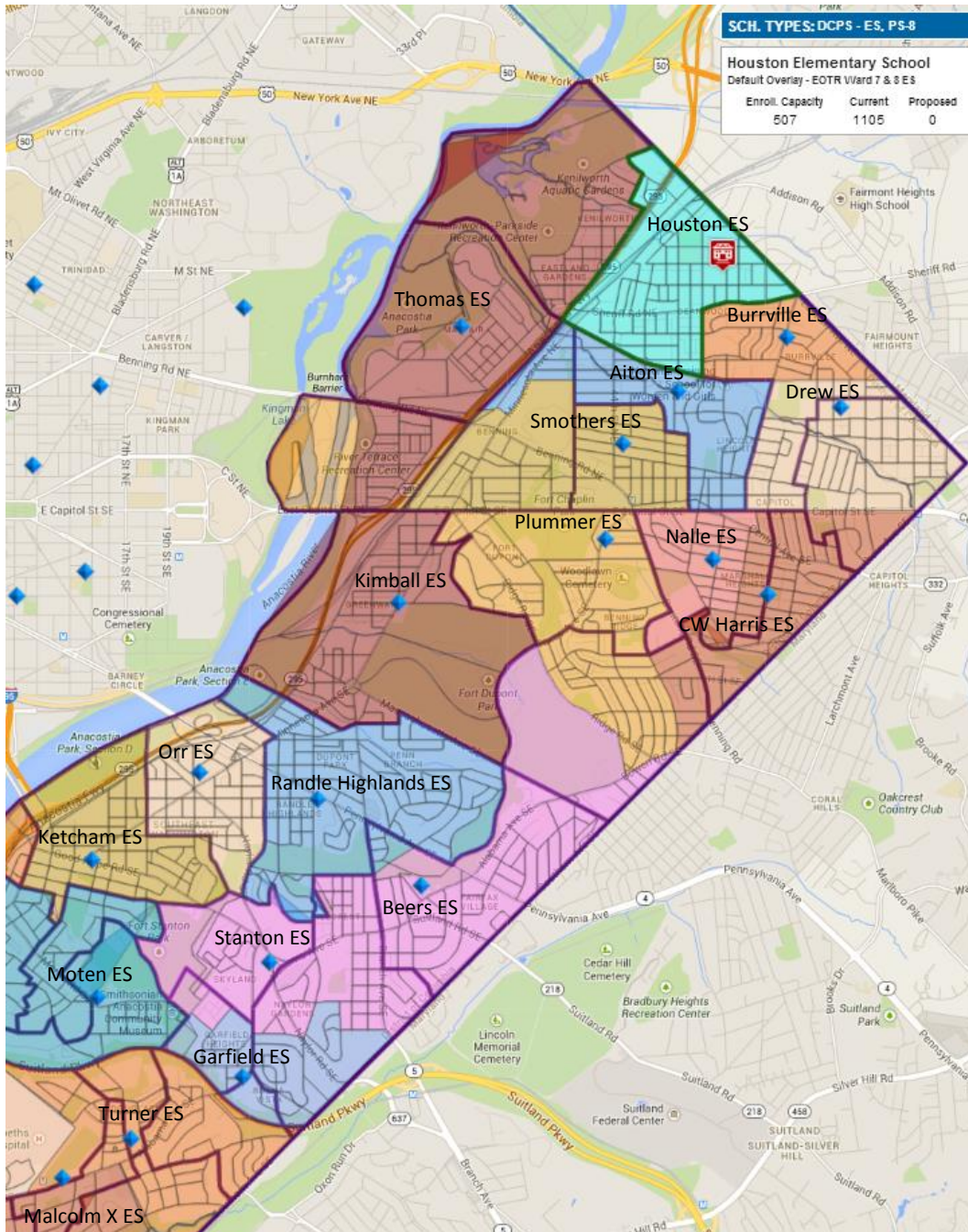

Preliminary Boundary Revisions for DCPS Elementary Schools

Initial Decision Factors	Proposed Boundary Changes
<p>Incorporate closed school boundaries: River Terrace, Kenilworth, Davis, Benning, Fletcher Johnson, Winston, Wilkinson, and Birney.</p> <p>Aim to re-allocate students into schools with low enrollment as possible given distance and barriers.</p>	<p>Reallocate areas from within their boundaries to adjacent DCPS elementary schools.</p> <p>Consolidate Kenilworth, River Terrace and Thomas boundaries.</p> <p>Consolidate Benning and Smothers, with few blocks included in Aiton boundary.</p> <p>Expand Drew boundary to Burrville boundary closest to Drew.</p> <p>Consolidate Davis boundary with C.W. Harris, Plummer and Beers.</p> <p>Reduce Nalle boundary to address building capacity with increase to CW Harris boundary.</p> <p>Expand Beers, Garfield, Stanton boundary to absorb Winston.</p>
<p>There are long distances and steep terrain for walking; inadequate public transit and numerous natural barriers—Fort Dupont; Chaplin Park; Woodland Cemetery; Rt. 295; the Anacostia River; East Capital Street; Benning Rd; Minnesota and Pennsylvania Avenues, Nannie H. Burroughs.</p>	<p>Develop DCPS transportation plan for elementary schools including the possibility of school district provided transportation if students are more than .5 mile from their school of right.</p>
