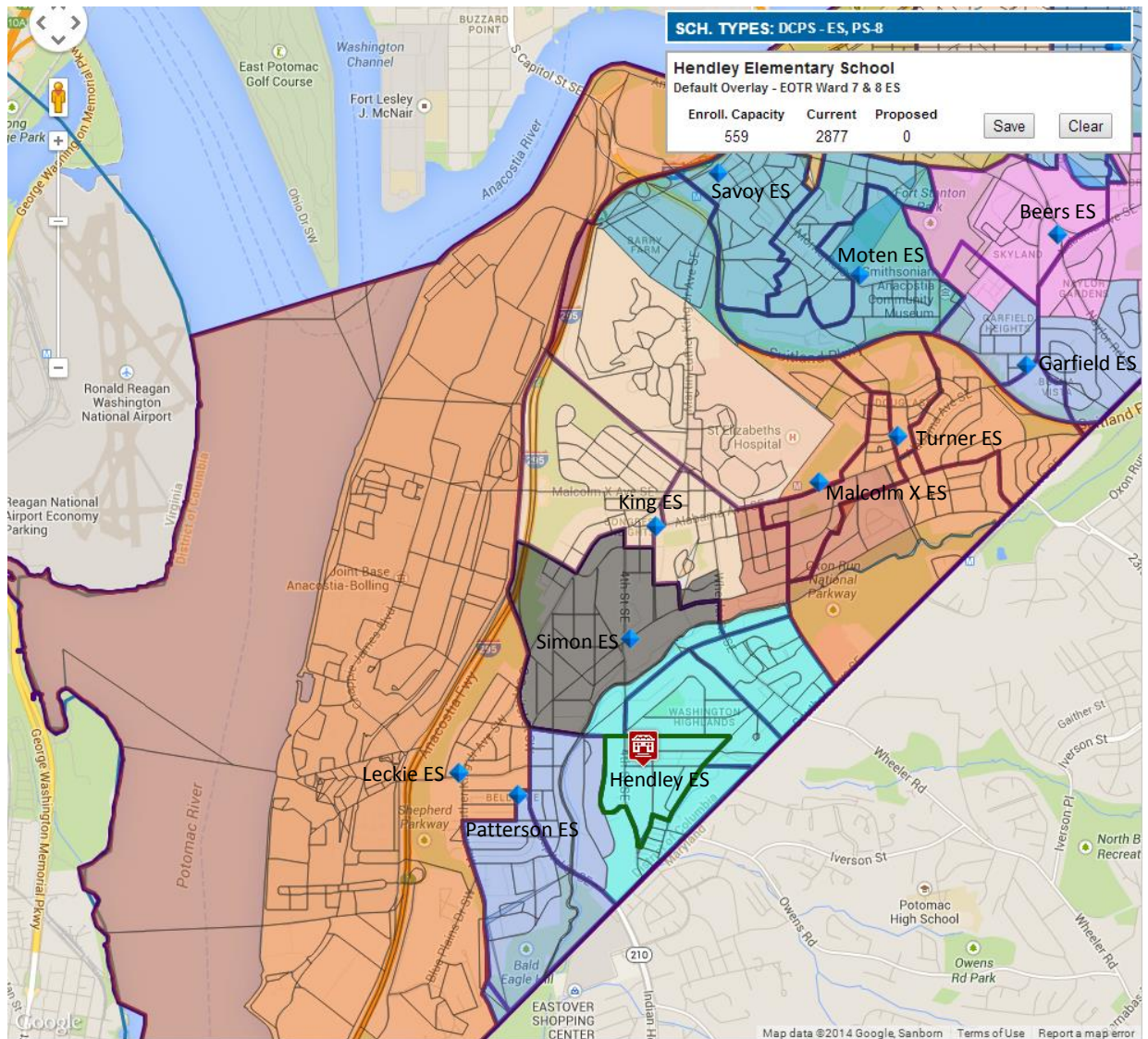

Preliminary Boundary Revisions for DCPS Elementary Schools

Bold lines are current DCPS elementary school boundaries. Shaded color areas are current and proposed DCPS elementary attendance zones.

Initial Decision Factors	Proposed Boundary Changes
Incorporate closed school boundaries: Ferebee-Hope, Draper, M.C. Terrell, McGogney, Green, Wilkinson, Birney and PR Harris	Reallocate the area within these boundaries to adjacent schools.
Concerns about crowding at Henley.	Expand Patterson boundary to relieve crowding at Henley; check crossing lights at S. Capitol St. at Patterson.
Concerns with walkability for students.	Students in former Birney boundary across from Malcolm X and Turner are reassigned to nearby schools. Check for sidewalks, crossing lights along Firth Sterling Ave. at Suitland Pkwy.
Concerns about walkability for students. Concerns about the potential for crowding since capacity of DCPS school of right and child population in the boundaries are not closely aligned.	Explore possible public school bus routes along MLK Jr. and Alabama Ave to assist families with transportation logistics.
Concerns for Turner capacity.	Turner boundary expands to absorb Garfield (which moved east of Suitland Pkwy. to absorb Winston) and Green.
