



SafeTrack Impacts on DC Schools

Metro's year-long track maintenance program, SafeTrack, will have a significant effect on students and staff who use Metrorail as a part of their commute. Reduced rail service along the lines where work is being conducted will result in extreme crowding and delays of an hour or more. Please familiarize yourself with the plan, and seek alternative travel options to avoid high-impact areas. - All students who use the Orange, Blue or Silver Lines between Minnesota Avenue, Benning Road, Stadium-Armory, Potomac Ave and Eastern Market Stations can use free shuttle buses operating between these stations.
- All students who use the Orange, Blue or Silver Lines should allow extra travel time or seek alternative travel options, as Orange and Silver Lines will operate every 10 minutes outside the shutdown zone, and the Blue Line will run every 12 minutes between Franconia-Springfield and Arlington Cemetery only.

- All students who use the Red Line between Fort Totten, Brookland, Rhode Island Avenue and NoMa Stations can use free shuttle buses operating between these stations.
- All students who use the Red Line should allow extra travel time or seek alternative travel options, as Red Line trains will operate outside the shutdown zone every 5 minutes between Shady Grove to NoMa and every 10 minutes between Glenmont to Fort Totten.

- All students who use the Blue or Yellow Lines should allow extra travel time or seek alternative travel options, as Blue Line trains will operate every 18 minutes, and Yellow Line trains will operate every 6 minutes between Reagan National Airport and Mt Vernon Square only.
