SCHOOL	CONCERN RAISED	COMMITTEE MEMBER PROPOSAL/COMMENTS
Kelly Miller/Sousa	CW Harris and JC Nalle should remain in Kelly Miller/Woodson feeder pattern due to access and transportation issues for families getting to Sousa/Anacostia	
Key ES	Foxhall Village should remain in Key boundary because: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Key doesn't have a capacity issue with the temporary classrooms • Access/transportation issues going through Georgetown to get to Hyde ES 	
Stoddert ES	Burleith community should remain in the Stoddert boundary because: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community cohesion • Doesn't solve capacity issues at Stoddert 	
Crestwood/16 th Street Heights	Losing access to high quality MS/HS in exchange for new middle school with unknown performance. Community wants to retain access to Deal/Wilson	
Oyster-Adams	Increasing the boundary poses challenges to the 50/50 dual-language model. Should consider alternatives to mitigate for this.	
Columbia Heights Education Campus	Non dual-language schools included in the feeder pattern. Reduced feeders into CHEC middle grades from 4 to 2 elementary schools.	
Coolidge, Roosevelt, Cardozo High Schools	Lack of adequate middle schools to support robust feeder pattern to support a robust high school enrollment.	
Van Ness ES	Proposed boundary does not have enough students in it to support a school.	
Tyler ES	Community wants Tyler to continue to feed

Ross ES	Wants feeder rights to Francis Stevens until new Center City is available.	
SWS	Some community members want proximity preference at the school (currently citywide).	
Eaton ES	Community does not want to feed to Hardy, wants to remain in Deal feeder pattern.	
Eastern/Woodson	Concerns with losing access to Eastern. Concerns with access and transportation issues getting to Woodson.
